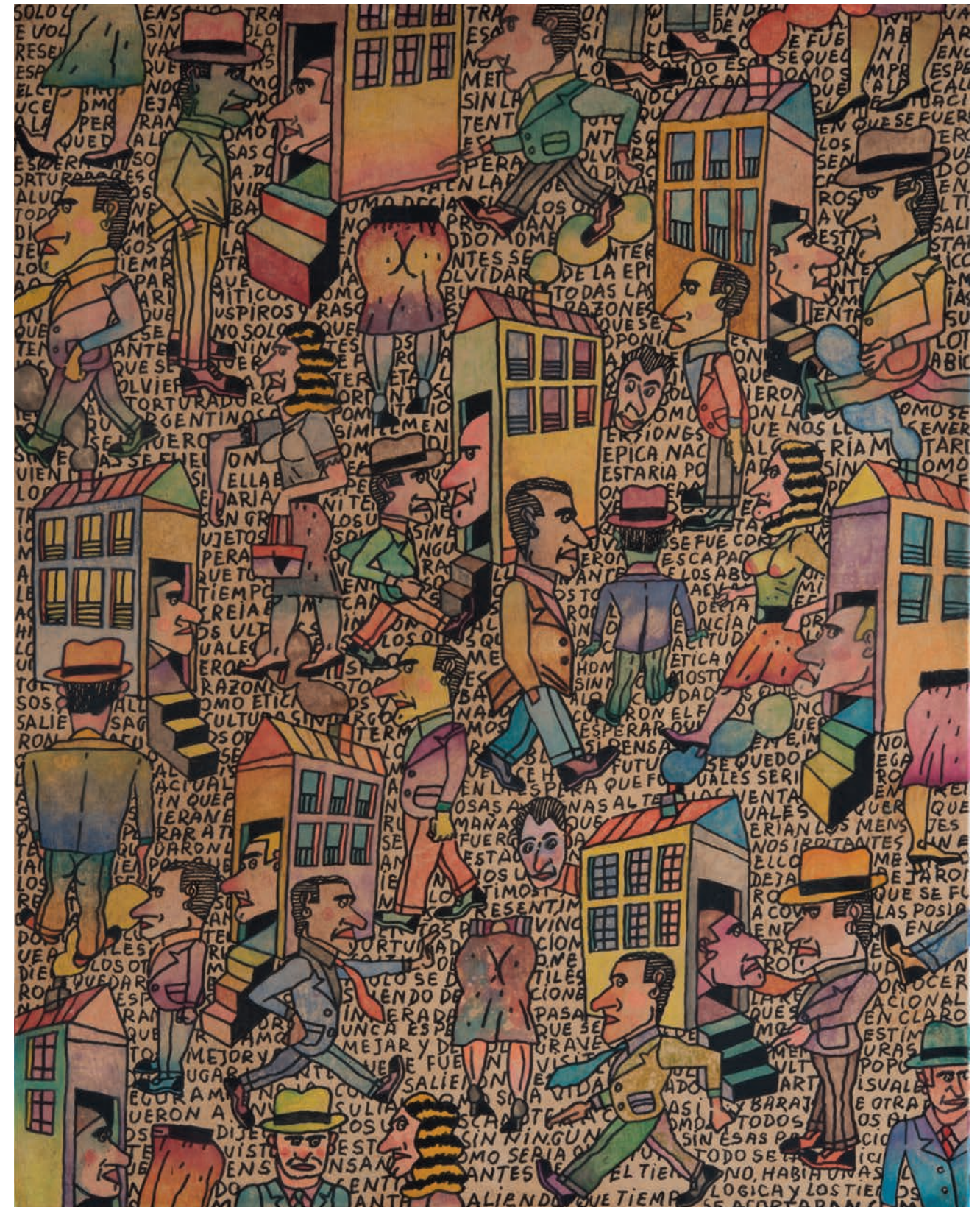

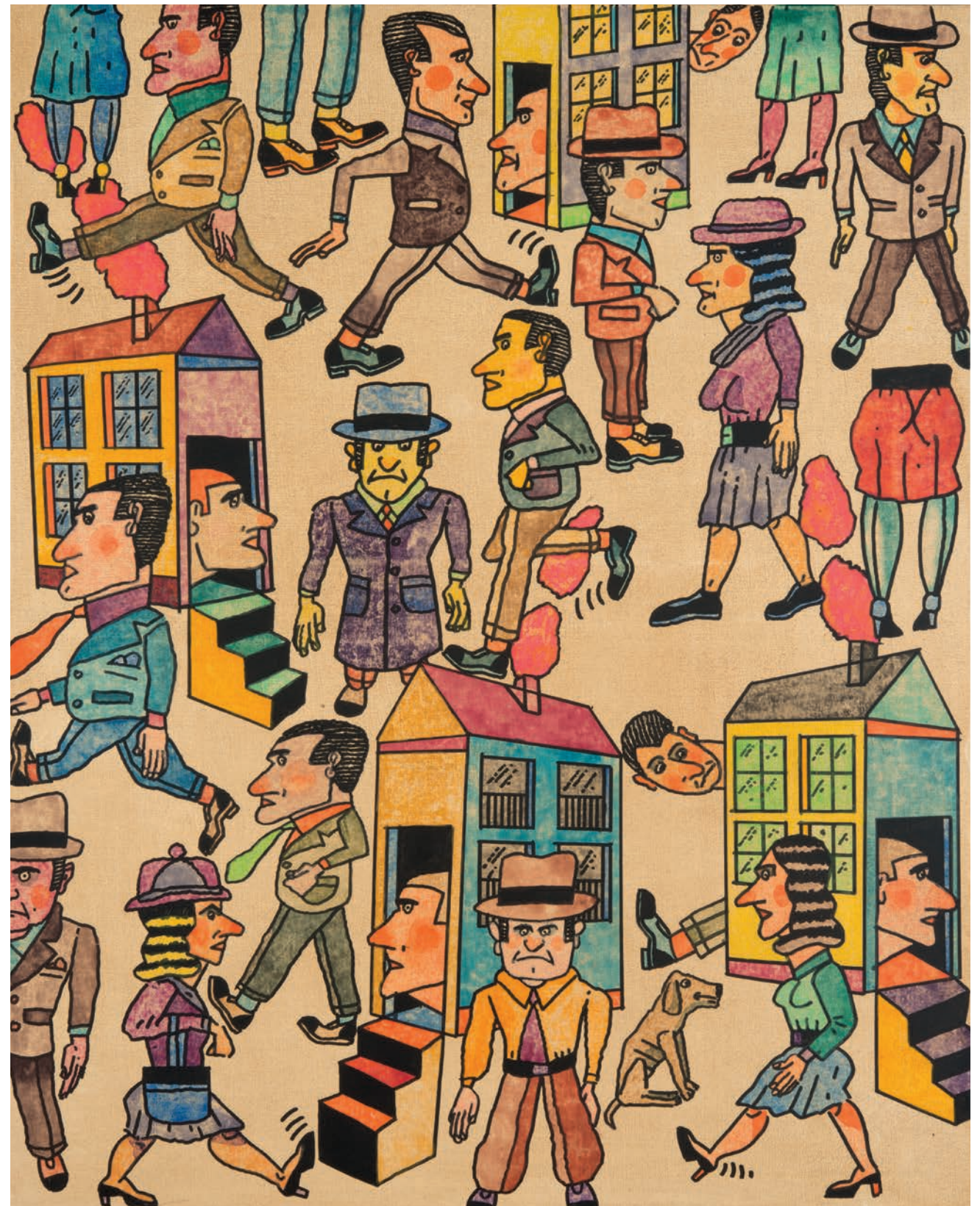

**Antonio Seguí** was born in Córdoba, Argentina in 1934. He left Argentina in 1963 to settle permanently in Paris, France, and is based in the same studio in Arcueil since his arrival. Seguí has held over 100 individual exhibitions, won awards on five continents and taught at the l'École nationale supérieure des Beaux-Arts. His work is in collections of major art museums throughout the world.

Seguí's painting is rich in tonal contrasts, a constant interplay between elaborate backgrounds and the multicolored personages that traverse a painting's surface, each in a world of his own. The most recognizable feature of Seguí's work is the caricaturesque draughtsmanship, which gives a vibrant cadence to the flow of the nameless multitudes. What is singular in the work is the artist's capacity to give a cast of thousands the hope of a certain individuality.

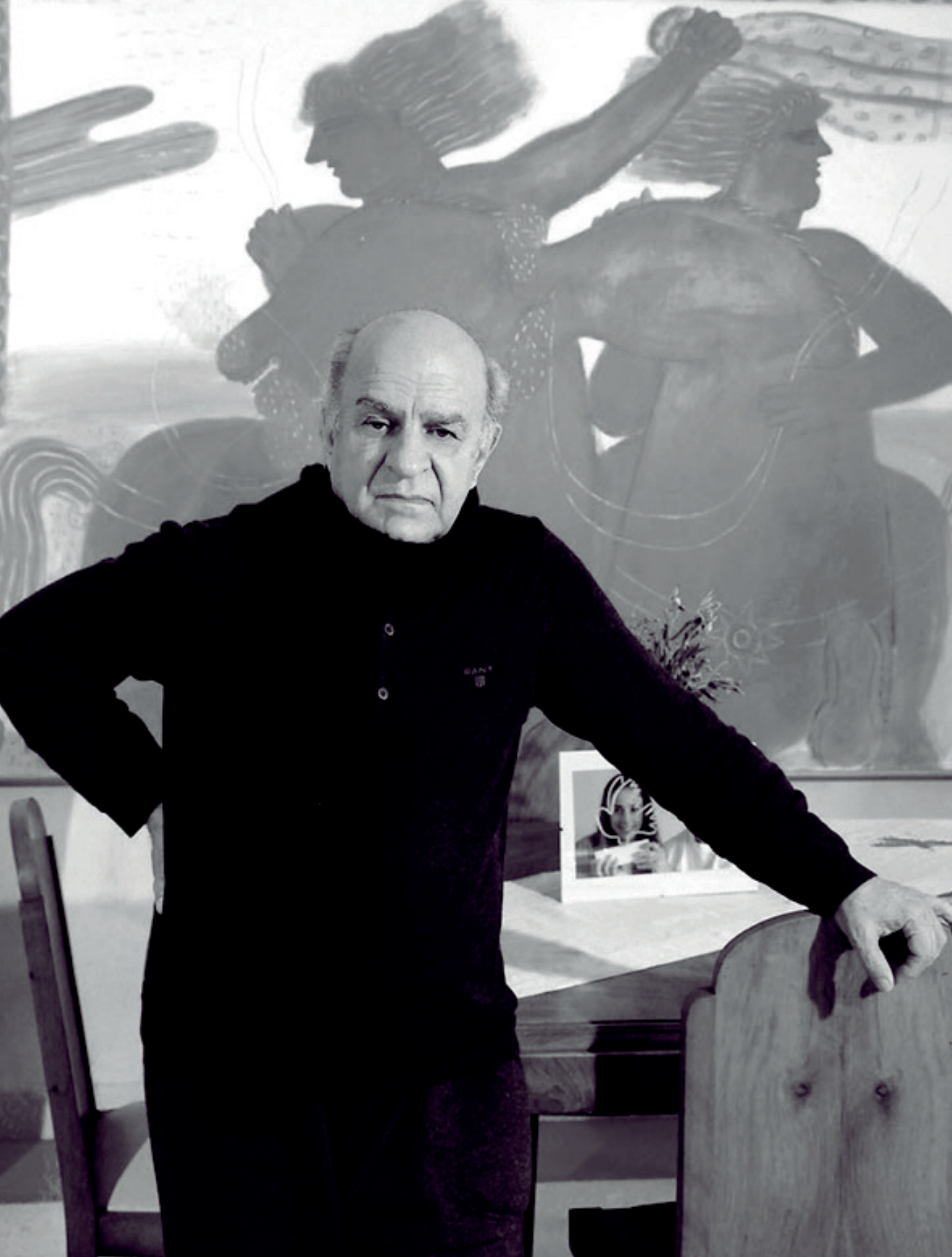

**Alecos Fassianos** was born in Athens in 1935. He graduated from the Athens School of Fine Arts, then in 1960 moved to Paris to study lithography at the Paris National School of Fine Arts, where he met the remarkable artists and writers of those times.

Alecos Fassianos created stage designs for major classic and modern plays, seeking out its own unique artistic forms at the same time.

His artworks are exhibited in museums all over the world and can be found in private collections of a large number of countries. Alecos Fassianos retrospective and solo exhibitions have been organized in museums and galleries around the world, particularly in Athens, Paris and throughout Europe, as well as in Tokyo, New York, Sao Paulo and Melbourne.

In addition to private collections, his paintings can be found in France: at the Museum of Modern Art of Paris, at the «MAEGHT» Foundation, Saint Paul de Vence, at the Pompidou Center for Contemporary Art, etc.

The artist presently lives and works in Athens, Greece, but always refers to France as his second home.
